- 1. The promoter for this competition is CODE Student Accommodation
- 2. The competition is open to CODE Coventry residents for the 21/22 Academic year
- 3. There is no entry fee and no purchase necessary to enter this competition
- 4. By entering this competition, an entrant is indicating his/her agreement to be bound by these terms and conditions.

- 6. Closing date for entries will be 5pm on Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> September. After this date, no further entries to the competition will be permitted.
- 7. Entries need to be sent to <u>marketing@codestudents.co.uk</u>, along with entrant name, email and room number. If entries are not sent to <u>marketing@codestudents.co.uk</u> and only shared on social media, then they will not be counted
- 8. No responsibility can be accepted for entries not received for whatever reason.

- 11. 4 entries per person. 1 image/1 video counts as 1 entry.
- 12. The most creative entry will win and will be judged by a panel of staff and students.
