

### **Advice while living at CODE**

1. Please be mindful of your neighbours when entering & leaving the site. Others may have early lectures, assignments due or exam revision to focus on. Local residents might not be students, may work full-time and have small children so please be considerate.
2. When moving around the site please ensure all gates and doors are securely closed behind you. If someone tries to follow you into a building, please ask them to present their own fob and they will be able to access the building themselves. Tailgating is one of the most common methods of theft in student accommodation.
3. If you plan on having a few friends over, please use the communal spaces provided, there are there for you to get together with friends and have fun but, please remember to leave them clean and tidy so others can enjoy them too. By using these rooms, you will minimise disruption to your neighbours and will help prevent noise complaints against your flat.
4. Music – we have no problem with you playing music please be mindful of the volume. Bass/stereo equipment is typically what causes most noise complaints. While you may have no assignments due, your neighbours may have been up all night revising for that crucial exam. The general rule is if you can hear it outside your flat with the door closed, it's too loud.
