

Smoking & Drug Policy

Smoking/Drug Use on Site: -

Please note that for health and safety reasons, smoking (including E-cigarettes and shisha) is banned in all CODE Buildings, including your flat.

To ensure student safety and to minimise the risk of fire, a charge of £50 will be added to your account if at any time you are found to be smoking inside the building. Payment will be due within 7 days to the CODE Office.

Please use the smoking areas provided – They are clearly marked with signage & cigarette bins all around CODE sites.

We operate a zero-tolerance policy in relation to any illegal activity. We do not tolerate any illegal substances or legal highs (psychoactive substances) at CODE and any such activity will be immediately reported to the police, university & your guarantor/next of kin. We have a Police Office on site and officers regularly patrol all blocks to ensure our sites remain safe and drug free.

Smoking & Drugs Policy Procedure

First Stage - Written Warning and £50 charge.

Second Stage - Written Warning and £50 charge.

Third Stage - Written Warning and £50 charge. Tenant will also be required to attend a meeting with a CODE Manager. Local Police and a University Official will be invited to attend. Tenant's guarantor or next of kin will be notified.

Fourth Stage – Cancellation of contract due to breach of obligation.
